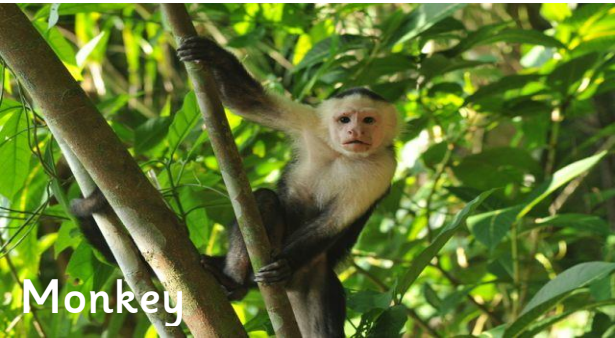


# Jungle Mania Knowledge Organiser

- Can you ask a family member if they have been to a jungle or rainforest.

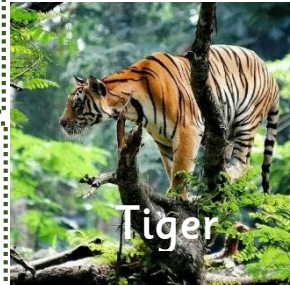


We will be using a range of books to support our learning. These are some book suggestions:

## Key vocabulary on Enchanted woodland

|                  |   |
|------------------|---|
| Jungle           | An area of land that is overgrown with thick forest, usually in tropical countries.   |
| Rainforest       | A rainforest is a thick forest of tall trees which is found in tropical areas where there is a lot of rain.   |
| Tropical weather | Hot and damp weather  |
| Extinction       | Extinction of a particular animal or plant species occurs when there are no more of that species alive anywhere in the world - the species has died out |
| Endangered       | Serious risk of extinction  |
| Species          | Species is a group of animals, plants or other living things that all share qualities.  |
| reptile          | A cold-blooded animal (as a snake, lizard, turtle, or alligator) that breathes air and usually has the skin covered with scales or bony plates.         |
| Mammal           | To be a mammal, an animal must have fur or hair and drink their mother's milk when they are babies. They are warm-blooded animals.                      |
