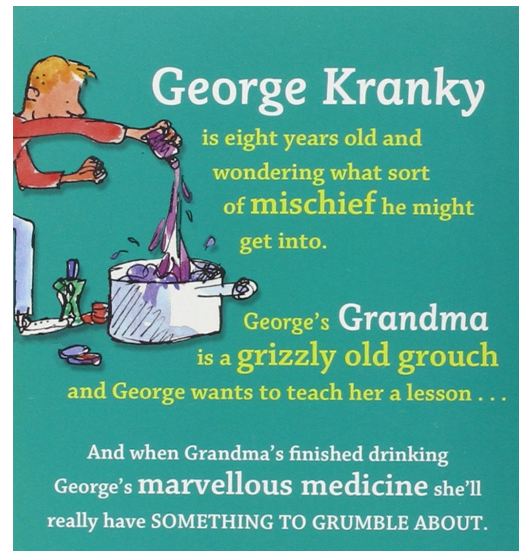
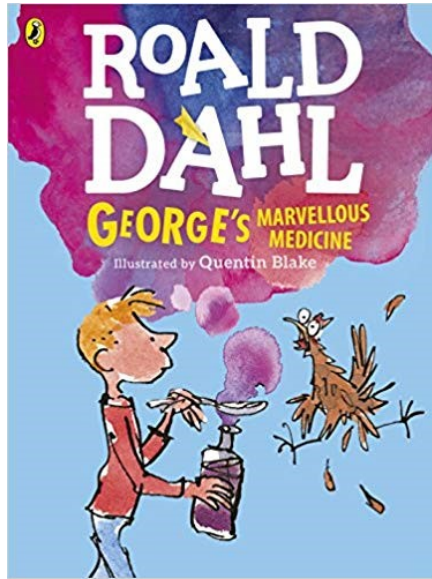


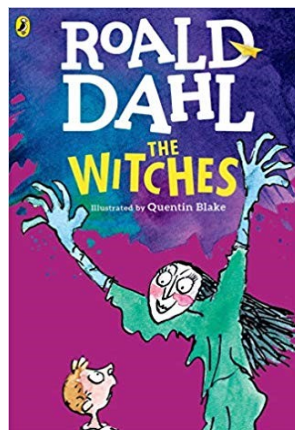
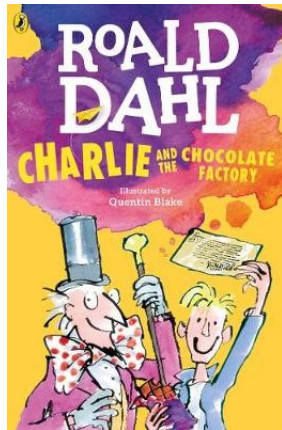
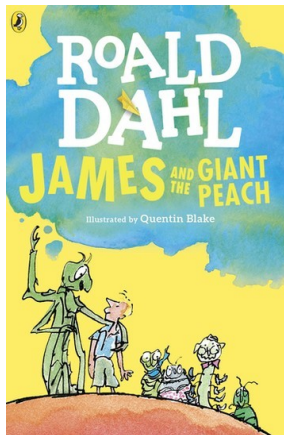
Take One Book

George's Marvellous Medicine by Roald Dahl



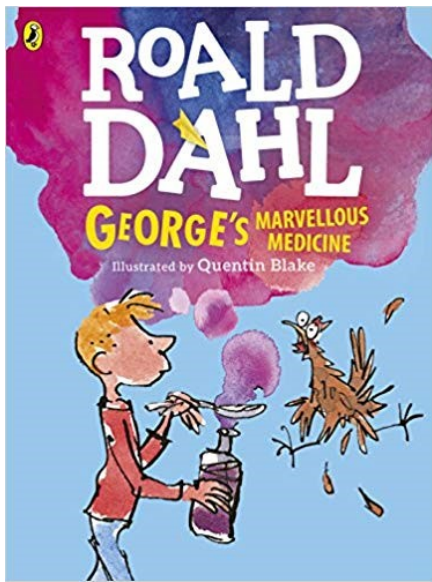
