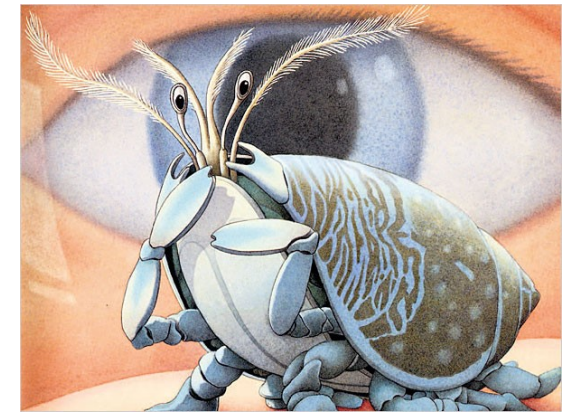
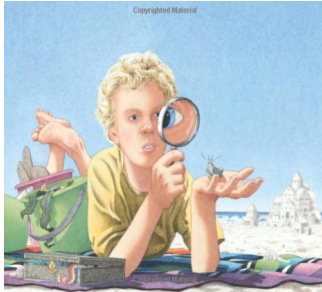


Take One Book Flotsam by David Wiesner

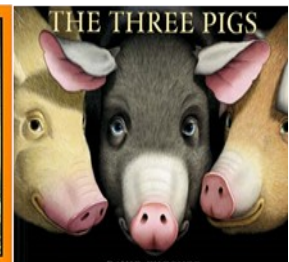
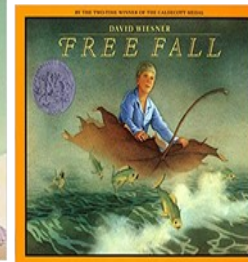
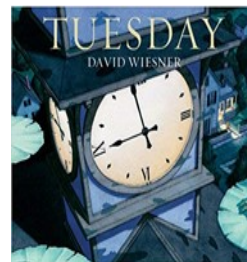


Flotsam is a graphic novel of many exciting pictures yet no words. This type of book allows us to run free with our imaginations. A picture tells a thousand words!
