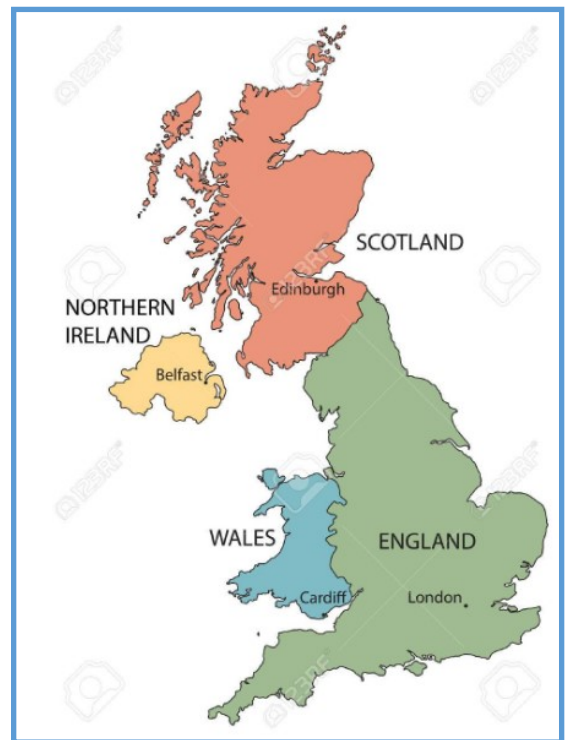

Spelling	Definition/Sentence
Mountain	A large steep hill
River	A large flow of water, that crosses land, heading towards the ocean
Lake	A large area of water, surrounded by land
Ocean	One of the 5 largest areas of salt water in the world
County	An area of the UK (smaller than a country)
Country	A nation with its own government
Capital	A city or town that is the home to government
Government	A group of people who make decisions about a country
Continent	1 of 7 large areas of land on Earth that is joined together
